

ASSAM, INDIA: KAZIRANGA NATIONAL PARK AND NAMERI NATIONAL PARK

This extension to our **<u>Birding Tour Bhutan: Spring in the Eastern Himalayas</u>** will lead to the Indian province of Assam, home to two magnificent national parks for us to visit; Kaziranga NP and Nameri NP. Either of these parks may allow us a glimpse of the majestic Bengal tiger; the former is the major stronghold of the otherworldly great Indian one-horned rhinoceros and features numerous other interesting mammals and wonderful birds; the latter is one of the best birding venues on the Indian subcontinent.

Please note that the detailed itinerary below cannot be guaranteed as it is only a rough guide and can be changed (usually slightly) due to factors such as availability of accommodation, updated information on the state of accommodation, roads, or birding sites, the discretion of the guides and other factors.

Itinerary (8 days/7 nights)

Day 1. Transfer to Kaziranga National Park

If you are coming from Bhutan, you will today arrive with us in Guwahati from Samdrup Jonkhar in Bhutan. Otherwise your tour begins in Guwahati. From here we will drive to Kaziranga (5 hours from Guwahati).

Overnight: a wildlife resort.

Day 2 – 4. Kaziranga National Park

The safaris will be in jeeps inside Kaziranga National Park, and the days will be spent in the various habitats of this fabulous park, looking for great Indian one-horned rhinoceros, **Pallas's Fish Eagle, Pied Harrier, Bengal Florican, Greater Adjutant,** and many others. Overnight: a wildlife resort

Day 5. Kaziranga National Park - Nameri National Park

We spend the early morning at the famous Panbari Mosque, and then we will drive to Nameri National Park to get a glimpse of the rare **White-winged Duck** and **Wreathed Hornbill**. Overnight: Nameri Eco Camp

Days 6 – 7 Nameri National Park

These two days will be spent birding at Nameri. Overnight: Nameri Eco Camp

Day 8. Departure

After early morning birding we drive to the airport in Guwahati. You can connect from here to Kolkata or New Delhi for your flights home.
